They help facilitate hands-on workshops by encouraging participation, providing support, and sharing their enthusiasm and unique skills with visitors.

Responsibilities:

- Create a welcoming, friendly, supportive environment for guests of all ages
- Engage guests of all ages with amazing science content, stories, and activities
- Assist with hands-on workshops and engineering challenges for field trips
- Help prepare for workshops by creating supply bins and sorting workshop materials
- During the workshop, assist groups in completing their assigned activities, and helping to test their design in engineering challenges
- Assist in resetting supplies in between workshops and restocking when finished

- An enthusiastic, out-going personality
- Bilingual in Spanish a plus
- Knowledge of, curious about, and/or enjoy engaging in conversations about STEM (science, technology, engineering and math) topics
- Willingness to initiate interactions with students grade K 8, their chaperones, and teachers
